Carly Fiorina became the first woman to lead a Fortune 20 company, serving as the Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Hewlett-Packard from 1999 to 2005. She was named Fortune's Most Powerful Woman in Business for six consecutive years. During her tenure at HP, Fiorina led the reinvention of this legendary company, tripling its rate of innovation, achieving market leadership, transforming its costs structure and accelerating growth. She is one of the most recognized business leaders in the world and an opinion leader who champions innovation, competitiveness and job creating.

Also active in politics, Fiorina ran against four-term Democratic Senator Barbara Boxer in California in 2010. She currently serves as the Vice Chairman of the National Republican Senatorial Committee. Fiorina is actively engaged in policy formulation and philanthropy, sitting on the boards of a wide range of organization. On April 18, 2012, Good360 announced that Fiorina would take over as the organization's new board chair.
